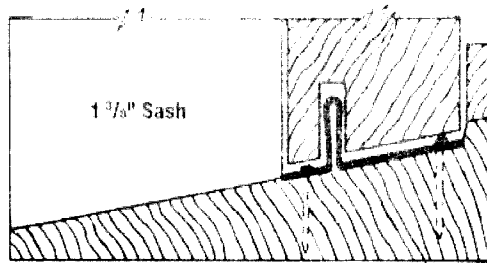

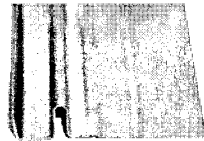
Head Section

Jamb Weatherstrip With Return Flange for Interlocking Wood Windows

This shape weatherstrip is used on the jambs of wood windows with interlocking style weatherstrip. The extra piece which touches the parting bead is called the return flange. Also available without the return flange.

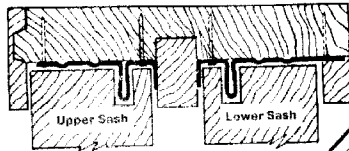

Jamb Weatherstrip Return Flange

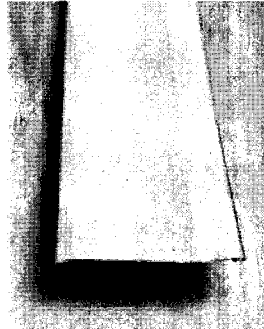

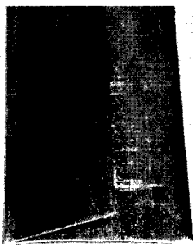

We show 3 types of spring bronze weatherstrip below. First there is the Pro-Type which is a single leaf and is sold in coils. Next there is the Cushion Type which has a V shaped cross section. The V shaped weatherstrip cannot be coiled and must be shipped in straight lengths. Finally we show the Interlocking type weatherstrip which is probably the best and most difficult to install.

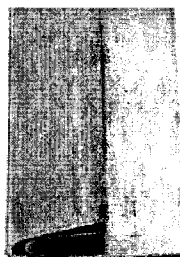

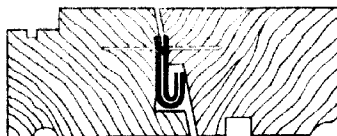

Meeting Rail Weatherstrip

Hook style meeting rail weatherstrip for double hung wood windows. The smaller hook is fastened to the lower sash and the larger hook is fastened to the upper sash. See detail below. Nails available separately. These strips are also used to weatherstrip doors.

Spring Bronze Lock Strips

When you are using spring bronze weatherstrip on a door, you cannot weatherstrip right next to the lock. These lock strips are used next to the lock. They are not usually used on the entire height of the door because of their greater resistance to compression.

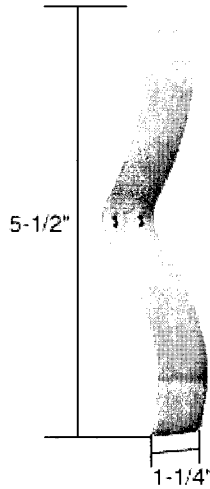

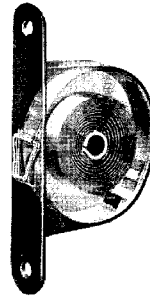

Spring Balances Bounce Back

A vintage window sash spring balance still has its appeal, with age.

Cords, weights, and pulleys have been holding sash open for well over 150 years and are still at work in thousands of old-house windows. All the while, manufacturers have tried to match their collectible cast-iron systems' proven class with simpler or cheaper, but only one came close: the sub-spring counterbalance. Often installed as original equipment, spring balances are worth knowing about because these devices are not only historically appropriate for retrofitting old windows, but they're also practical for solving some common modern old-house problems.

The Source of Springs

In the 1800s, as the Industrial Revolution was reaching its peak, technological achievement became both the essence of the American spirit and good business. Everyone wanted to potent a better tomorrow, and there was a steady stream of novel inventions seeking to improve every industry, including building construction. The need to conveniently control double-hung sash had spawned in any number of ways, even came and ratchets to tension bars and spring pins, but the spring balance, which first appeared in the 1850s, was something
